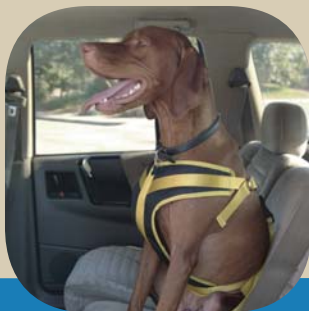

BUCKLE UP

The American Pet Products Manufacturing Association (APPMA) issued a warning to Americans traveling with pets. According to the group, a majority of the 40 million pets expected to hit the roads during a typical vacation season will not be properly restrained, causing unnecessary safety hazards to pets and people alike.

As an example, the group notes, an unsecured 60 pound dog could hit a window, backseat or another passenger with a force of 1,200 pounds in a 30 mile-per-hour collision.

APPMA is urging Americans to buckle up pets with its "Be Sure to Secure" national travel safety campaign. "There are many easy-to-use restraint devices, including harnesses and crates, which limit distractions and keep pets and others safe while traveling," said Funda Alp, spokesperson for APPMA.
